





RIDE ALONG-PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

In order to obtain the revocable permission and consent of The University of Texas at Austin to accompany one or more of its police officers during their law enforcement patrol, and only so long as doing so is mutually agreeable by the officer and participant, I hereby make the following representations and acknowledgements upon which I intend The University of Texas at Austin to rely, namely: I understand that, in participating in The University of Texas at Austin Police Department's Ride Along program, I have no active role whatsoever, but am to be an unarmed observer and by-stander. I will have, and am given no duties, rights, powers, or authority whatsoever other than those conferred by law upon any other person in a similar or like situations or circumstances. I realize that, while not being the agent, servant or employee of The University of Texas at Austin and therefore not covered under Workman's Compensation for any benefits thereof, be unpredictably placed, from time to time in both foreseeable and unforeseeable positions of danger so long as I choose to continue to participate in the Ride Along program. The exposure may continue in some instances despite my desire to withdraw because of the nature of the activity involved.

In consideration and as a condition of the opportunity afforded me to participate in the Ride Along program, while it is mutually agreeable between The University of Texas at Austin, myself and each officer in whose company my participation will from time to time place me, that while I continue to participate, I therefore agree, binding my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, that The University of Texas at Austin and its police and other officers, employees and agents shall not be held liable nor accountable in damages for harm or loss to my property or for personal injuries or death sustained by me while participating in this program.
